Agenda for California: An African-American Perspective

Shortly after Governor Newsom's resounding electoral victory, transition team "All-in California" Ambassadors, Supervisor Mark Ridley-Thomas and UC Regent Laphonza Butler, convened a coalition of African-American leaders to address urgent issues that African-Americans face throughout the state. This month marks the dividend of this convening – and numerous subsequent meetings – with the release of the Agenda for California: An African-American Perspective.

Embodying the ethos of the people powered approach Gov. Newsom sought in his selection of the duo as "All-in California" Ambassadors, wanting "respected leaders to help him search for innovative ideas and talent across the state", the Agenda for California: An African-American Perspective answers this call and more.

"As a community, we've been disproportionately impacted in so many areas of social well-being that animating the California 'Dream for All' in the face of this inexorable truth will take leadership, imagination, and an attentiveness to innovative and focused policy," said Supervisor Ridley-Thomas.

"This Agenda does just that through policy priorities that are achievable, scalable, and evidenced-based. It's a rock solid foundation for Gov. Newsom's Administration to build on."

Edited by Dr. Ange Marie Alfaro-Hancock, a leading academic on

intersectional theory, the Agenda delivers to Governor Newsom a sharp and interconnected perspective on five critical policy areas: early childhood education, ending child poverty, fighting homelessness, expanding access to healthcare, and improving redevelopment and economic development. Each section includes not just a diagnosis of challenges, but also provides high-impact solutions that will stem the tide in problem areas Californians face in their daily lives.

The initial gathering, held at SEIU2015 headquarters, included an array of participants from various sectors and industries. Academics, business leaders, philanthropic leaders, healthcare providers, artists, media managers, ecumenical and civil rights leaders, labor, educators, and many more shared their experiences and divided into daylong working groups. Using their respective areas of professional expertise, participants put forth a range of pol-

icy solutions to counteract the complex risk factors that originate in racism, sexism, poverty, and geographic inequities to empower Californians to seize the "Californian Dream".

"I'm excited to have been a part of this special process focused on providing practical solutions to the unique systematic challenges that our community face", said Dr. David Carlisle, President and CEO of Charles Drew University of Medicine and Science, referencing the outgrowth of the work from that day. "This policy brief will provide an outstanding foundation for measurable concrete action and chart a path to a more prosperous and equitable future for the state of California."

ATTENTION: CAROUSEL TRACT RESIDENTS

STREET SWEEPING ENFORCEMENT

All who park their vehicles in the non-construction areas - more than 150 feet away from the remediation work, and on all streets not under construction in the rest of the Carousel Tract, must abide by all parking laws and posted signs, including "No Parking on Street Sweeping Days."

- "No Parking Anytime" will be placed adjacent to the sound walls (and extend 50ft on each side)
- "Parking Allowed" will be placed thereafter (at 50ft-100ft on each side)

Remediation Project Background

The Carousel Tract is comprised of 285 single-family residences located on the former Kast Property Tank Farm. It is currently undergoing a "Cleanup and Abatement" by Shell Oil, as issued by the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board in 2011, where soil is being excavated to be cleared of petroleum hydrocarbons and other contaminants of concern.

Parking Enforcement will be issuing citations to vehicles in violation of the law immediately in the non-construction zones although the special parking signage will be posted on June 3 at construction zones. Relief to residents parked away from the clusters at the non-construction locations is not necessary since those areas are not being impacted by the street reduction or closure by sound walls. All who park their vehicles in the non-constructions zones should abide by all parking laws and posted signage throughout the rest of the Carousel Tract.

AC HOTEL LOS ANGELES SOUTH BAY NEARS COMPLETION

We’re meeting a growing demand on various levels by introducing a whole new quality of hotel product.” Built by AXIS/GFA Architecture + Design, AC Hotel Los Angeles South Bay is part of the hotel and office project at Elevon Campus. Nestled near LAX and El Segundo’s various aviation and tech industries, the concept is derived from the surrounding area. With a blend of angular and curved surfaces inspired by aeronautical shapes and airfoils, the building’s forms, lines and profiles reflect the visual imagery of flight and avionics. Intermixed with these forms is the static window and glass grid, which complements the angled lines, while silver metal panels mimic the color of an airplane’s wings and suggest motion, against a backdrop of rich and stable smooth stucco for depth.

Design Force is behind AC Hotel Los Angeles South Bay’s interior look and feel, which, similar to the hotel’s exterior, is locally inspired. The dichotomy of nature and aerospace served as an underlying influence of the design. The space will combine hues of warm neutrals, fresh greys and cool metals accented by leathery cordovan, while showcasing original metal artwork and an overall geometry of flight motif throughout in homage to its surroundings.

Councilmember Joe Buscaino: Hamilton Avenue Rebuilding Nears Completion



In 2011, the Paseo Del Mar landslide altered traffic flows throughout San Pedro, particularly in and around the adjacent residential and collector streets. This increased traffic highlighted some of the existing conditions of the streets that needed to be addressed while the City continues to work on a permanent solution for Paseo Del Mar.

One of these projects was the Hamilton Avenue project: a two-block stretch of road that was only ever half-built. Previously the street was half asphalt with curb, gutter, and sidewalk while the other half was just dirt. The street was narrow and two cars couldn’t pass each other without one pulling into the dirt. This created very

unsafe driving conditions and with the increased traffic, the problem was compounded.

The Hamilton Avenue widening was a collaborative effort between Council District 15 and the Bureau of Engineering. Through the Councilmember’s efforts, the project was fully funded. In addition to building the other half of the road, the project also installed new fencing, sidewalks, gates, and

The Class of 2019 enjoyed a more intimate graduation experience in the Dignity Health Sports Park's Tennis Stadium on May 17 and 18 at California State University, Dominguez Hills (CSUDH) during six college-based Commencement ceremonies, each with stands full of family and friends cheering on the graduates.

Long Beach selected to host forum for Democratic presidential



Long Beach will get a turn in the national spotlight as the venue for a forum in November for Democratic presidential candidates running to unseat Donald Trump, California Democratic Party officials announced.

The forum will be hosted by Univision, the largest provider of Spanish-language news. It will be held during the party's Fall Endorsing Convention, to be held at the Long Beach Convention Center.

The forum itself will take place at the Long Beach Arena on Saturday, Nov. 16, during the party's second gathering this year. The party is also meeting in San Francisco this weekend, where 14 of the Democratic presidential candidates are expected to speak.

The Long Beach event is not a debate, acting party chair Alexandra Gallardo-Rooker said in a statement Friday. "It is a forum that will focus on issues important to Californians and to the Latino community," she said.

"We think it will be a fantastic addition to that convention and will once again highlight the importance of the Latino vote and California's impact in the Presidential Primary."

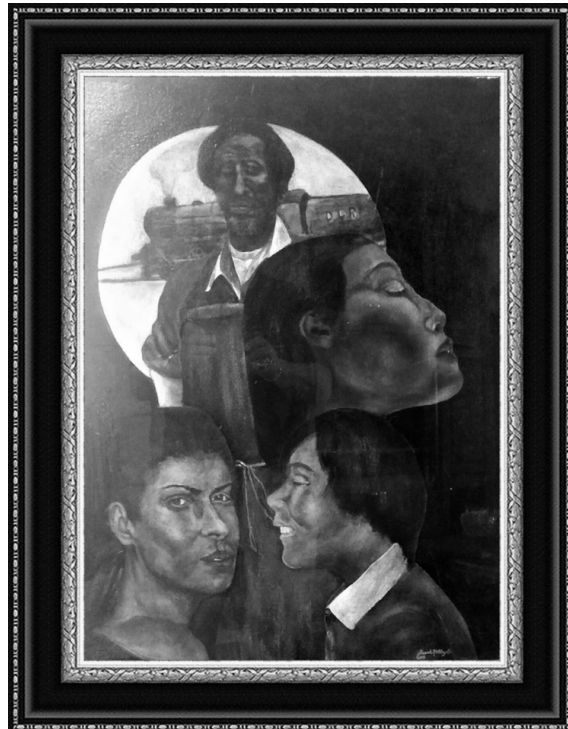
According to The Hill, the party will invite candidates who met criteria for inclusion in debates sanctioned by the Democratic National Committee. The DNC has said candidates must reach at least 2 percent support in several polls and earn donations from 130,000 individuals spread across many states.

More details will be announced as the event nears, officials said.

Long Beach Mayor Robert Garcia, who was named a state co-chair for the presidential campaign of Sen. Kamala Harris this week, said the city will host most of the Democratic candidates on a national stage.

The subject in this piece is the father of three children in different parts of the Northeast, Southeast and Eastern parts of the United States. He invested his love & financial

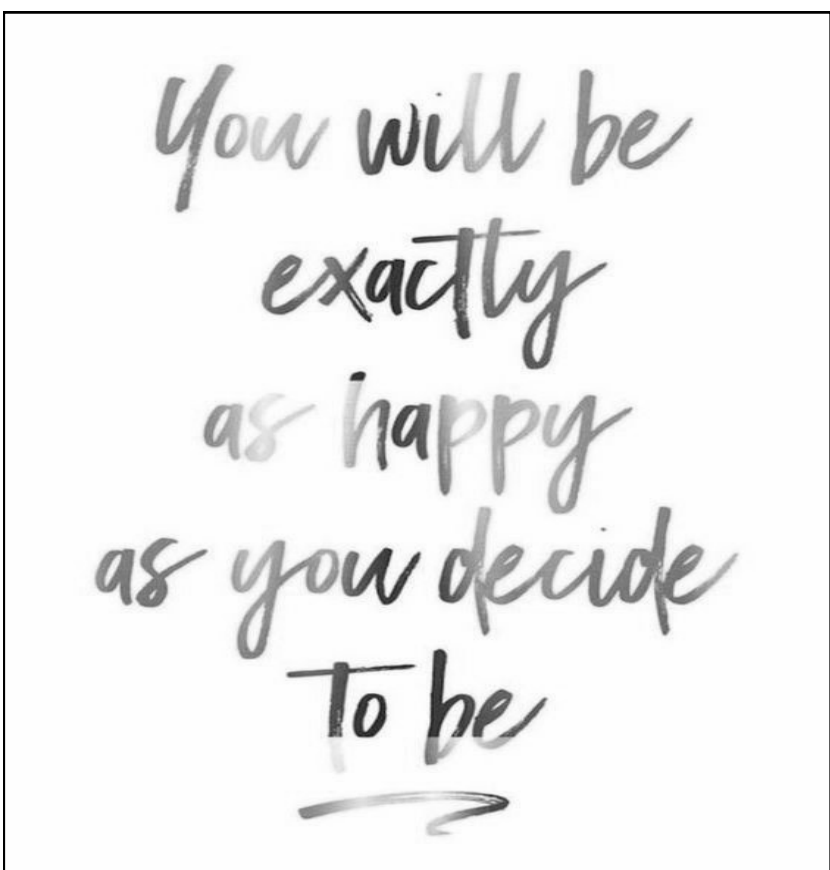

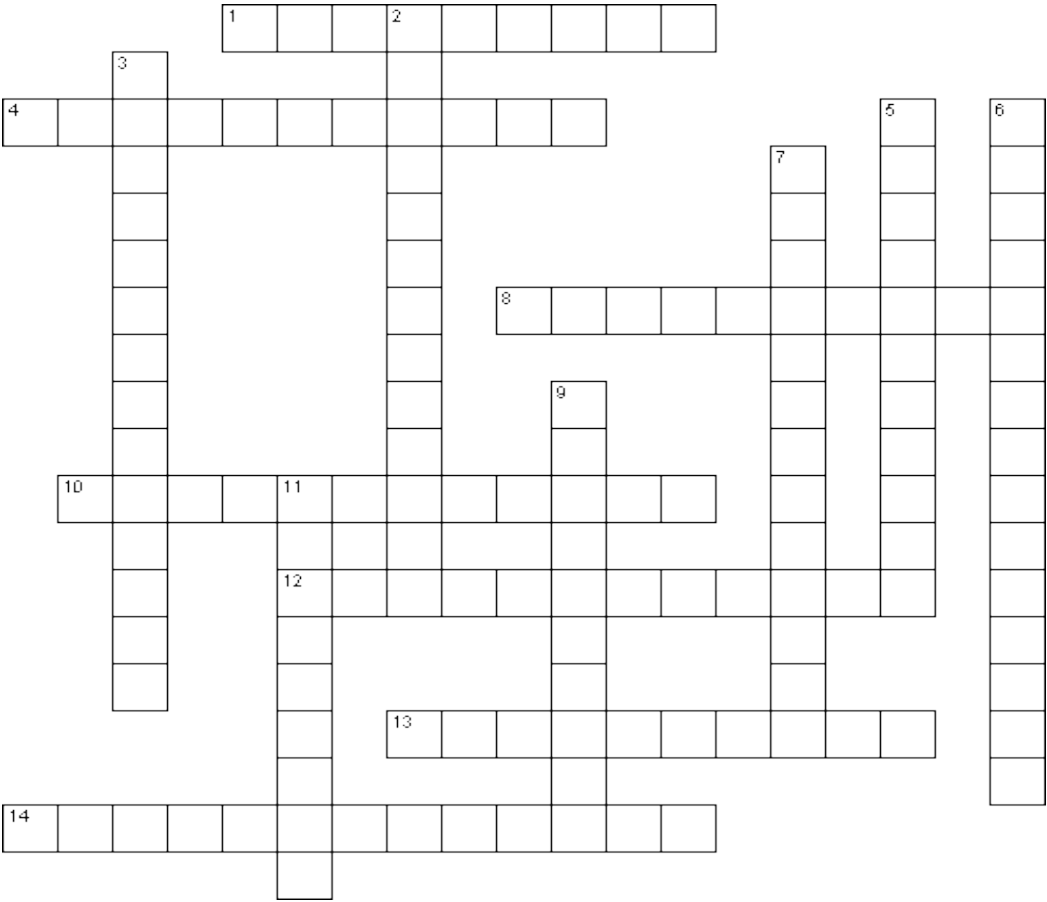
